5. ALL ARTICLES MUST BE CLEAN, no worn, soiled or unfinished articles will be accepted. Clothing and needlework must be pressed.
6. No articles may be entered in competition, which has been previously exhibited at the Crook County Fair.
7. If found that an article is entered in the wrong class, the superintendent or judge will change it to the proper class.
8. Items must be entered in categories as listed in the Fair Premium Book. If an item is not listed, it may be entered as exhibit only. If there are three or more items, to form a new class, already entered in others, a new class can be added, with the approval of the fair management.
