### SEE GENERAL AND OPEN CLASS LIVESTOCK RULES

#### DIVISION 103--YOUNGER YOUTH SHOW

1. For children ages 4 years through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
2. One entry only per child.
3. Unregistered animals of any age, females and altered males only.
4. No premiums paid out.
5. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded.
6. Class will be judged on showmanship, not conformation of animal.
7. Animal must be kept at the fair grounds during the fair but may be housed with a sibling's 4-H club with the okay from the 4-H Leader and Open Class Livestock Superintendent.

All Pygmy goat exhibitors will have their breed appropriate registration papers checked by the livestock superintendent or representative no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday August 5, 2009. Gate & parking passes will be handed out after all paperwork has been checked in with the superintendent or their representative.

All Goat exhibitors will be required to show proof of participation in the Scrapie program. All animals must have appropriate required Scrapie ID or Registration Papers.

1. Entries in the goat department will be limited to the capacity of the goat barn.
2. Each exhibitor/owner limited to two animals per class.
3. Exhibit only animals will be allowed if space is available after all paid entries are housed. No exceptions.
4. Each exhibitor will be required to have a herd sign. Decoration is encouraged.

5. Pens must be cleaned and bedded daily. Exhibitors will be expected to make sure their animals have feed and water at all times and are encouraged to be in attendance during open fair hours.
6. Only nursing bucks born after July 1, 2009 will be allowed at fair. Otherwise, no bucks are allowed.
7. Children 9 and under showing goats must have the goats horns capped or they must be dehorned.
8. Any animal showing signs of illness or contagious diseases will not be allowed. In case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be call at the owner's expense.
9. All animals in group classes must be shown in individual classes.
10. Exhibitors will be required to wear appropriate, clean clothing in the show ring. No sandals, tank tops, tube tops, or shorts.
