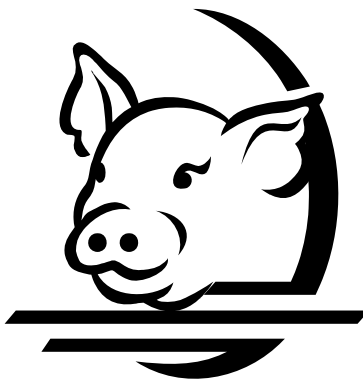

DIVISION 35

YOUNGER YOUTH SHOW

1. For children ages 4 years through 3rd grade.
2. One entry only per child.
3. Unregistered animals of any age, females and altered males only.
4. No premiums paid out.
5. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded.
6. Class will be judged on showmanship, not conformation of animal.
7. Animal must be kept at the fair grounds during the fair but may be housed with a sibling's 4-H club with the okay from the 4-H Leader and Open Class Livestock Superintendent.

All Swine exhibitors will have their breed appropriate registration papers checked by the livestock superintendent or representative no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday August 5, 2009.

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
Breed Champion males are eligible to compete.

CLASS:

244	Fall Sow, farrowed between July and December 31, 2008
245	Gilt, farrowed during January and February 2009
246	Gilt, farrowed during March and April 2009

◆
Champion and Reserve Champion
First and 2nd place winners in classes 244, 245, & 246 are eligible to compete.

◆
Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
Breed Champion females are eligible to compete.
