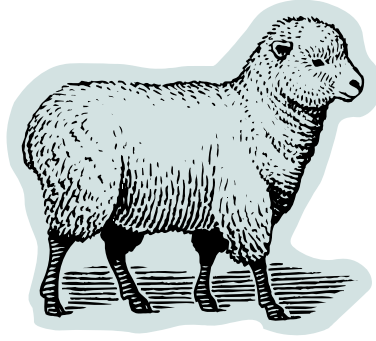

SEE GENERAL AND OPEN CLASS LIVESTOCK RULES

DIVISION 50--YOUNGER YOUTH SHOW

1. For children ages 4 years through 3rd grade.
2. One entry only per child.
3. Unregistered animals of any age, females and altered males only.
4. No premiums paid out.
5. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded.
6. Class will be judged on showmanship, not conformation of animal.
7. Animal must be kept at the fair grounds during the fair but may be housed with a sibling's 4-H club with the okay from the 4-H Leader and Open Class Livestock Superintendent.

All sheep exhibitors will have their breed appropriate registration papers checked by the livestock superintendent or representative no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday August 5, 2009. Gate & parking passes will be handed out after all paperwork has been checked in with the superintendent or their representative.

All sheep exhibitors will be required to show proof of participation in the Scrapie program. All animals must have appropriate required Scrapie ID.

Featured Breed

Natural Colored Wool Growers Association Registered Sheep

Exhibitors must be a member of the NCWGA but registered natural sheep from any association will be eligible for this show.

You must have a NCWGA membership card.

This show will be divided into three divisions- Fine, Medium, and Course/Long Wool Animals. The show is open to all Fine Wool Natural Colored Sheep (Grade 60+), Medium Wool Natural Colored Sheep (Grade 50-58) and Course/Long Wool Natural Colored Sheep (Grade 48 & below). The judge has the right to put sheep into proper divisions. Exhibitors must be a member of the Natural Colored Wool Growers Association, but registered Natural Colored Sheep from any association will be eligible for this show. Each exhibitor is limited to showing a total of 12 head in each division. Lamb break dates are: Senior lambs born September 1- December 31 and Junior lambs born January 1 and after. Champion and Reserve Champion Ram and Ewe Rosettes will be awarded in each division. Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder Awards will be awarded in each division. The Best Fleece classes are open to any animal previously shown in this show, one entry per exhibitor for each class. These classes will not be included in the tally of points towards Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor.

Lambs must have lambs teeth to be eligible for lamb classes.

All animals entered in pair, flock and Get classes **must be bred and owned by the exhibitor**. One group per exhibitor per class.
